The trustees of the Pierre Treuil Fund (PTF) and Unit 192 are happy to announce a second educational mentoring program to augment the learning curves of newer members of Unit 192. The very successful first program took place in early 2009 with eight clubs from Unit 192 participating. Since then, many individuals have approached club owners asking to be part of a mentoring program. The Unit and the PTF have agreed to provide funding for table fees for up to 20 Mentors from each club wanting to participate. The funding will cover up to 4 regular games for each Mentor. Although each Mentee will be responsible for his/her table fees, they will benefit from the experience of playing with a helpful mentor.

The Mentor and Mentee will be expected to play their 4 games during the period September 1, 2010 to December 1, 2010.

Any club that is interested in running this program is asked to appoint a coordinator who will be responsible for administering the program in that club.
